It has been 2000 years since Jesus lived. How can we still believe in a world that has changed so much since then? What challenges our faith today? What is the role of the Church in a culture that treats religion as just one of many personal options? These are some of the questions that will be raised in this series of Lenten talks and discussions. Each week we will talk about these issues from a different perspective: Faith in a Changing Church; Pope Francis – a disturbing Pope sent by God: Finding God in ordinary life; and the Future of the Church and the Church of the Future. Richard Shields, who teaches theology at the University of St. Michael's College and is a St. Augustine's parishioner, will facilitate each session.
