Campaign coming this way

Preparations are under way at St. Augustine's for the "One Heart, One Soul" Campaign, and across the diocese, early returns are promising! Through mid-May, 14 Pilot Wave parishes had raised a total of more than \$2.5 million, and an additional \$1.6 million had been pledged by other diocesan supporters and organizations. That total is about 12 percent of the campaign's \$35 million goal. The Pilot Wave will run through June, and three larger, additional waves will follow as the campaign gathers steam and continues through early 2021. St. Augustine's is among more than 30 parishes and a number of mission churches taking part in the next wave. Through the summer, preparations will include forming a volunteer team, developing campaign materials and identifying projects. Kickoff Weekend is tentatively set for September. The campaign is aimed at strengthening parishes and several diocesan wide ministries.

Dear Parishioners of St. Augustine,
We are delighted to invite you to see and purchase handmade religious articles made by the **Sisters of St. Elisabeth Convent (Belarus)**

The exposition will take place on **Tuesday, June 11th after the 7PM Mass in the Parish Centre.**

The Sisterhood of Saint Elisabeth was founded in 1996. For more than 20 years our sisters have been rendering spiritual, social and financial support to the sick and the suffering at the National Psychiatric Clinic, the boarding home for children with special needs and mentally challenged adults, a TB clinic.

In recent years a rehabilitation center for the homeless, drug and alcohol addicts, and ex-prisoners was established 20 miles away from the Convent.

Over 180 residents live here today. Many lost and struggling people get a chance to tackle their problems and start a new life with God.

A rehabilitation facility for females was established in 2012. Women released from jail, the homeless and mentally challenged women stay here. Today there are 30 women and one toddler at this farmstead.

To help those people workshops were established on the grounds of the Convent. Many of these sick people have a possibility to express themselves in art for God working together with sisters and making beautiful articles (hand painted icons, crosses, crucifixes, woodcarvings, embroidered and ceramic gifts, vestments.

All these goods are made with love and prayer and bring blessing to home. You will support many people in need by purchasing items of devotions for yourselves and your beloved ones.
