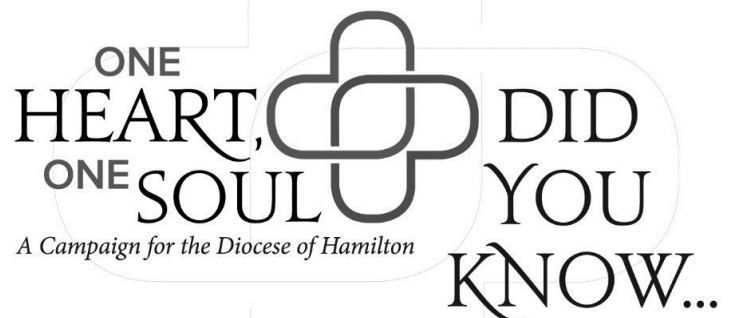
**ASSOCIATION OF DUNDAS CHURCHES
