#### A NEW FLOOR AND LIGHTING FOR THE

PARISH HALL: It's a good thing we're planning to replace our worn, aging floor. With a lighting upgrade, we'll be able to see it more clearly!

Of that, St. Augustine's keeps at least 75 percent.

If we raise \$270,000, we will receive a \$54,000 matching amount from the campaign!

That means we could receive from the campaign 95 percent of what we raise.
