MENTAL WELLNESS MOMENT:

Did you know?

Studies show that Prayer and Meditation can be very beneficial to mental wellness.

In times of stress or anxiety, turning to prayer can provide comfort and clarity. Setting aside a few minutes at the same time each day to pray or meditate allows us to connect with God and reflect on our thoughts and feelings. This practice can help ground us and bring peace to our minds, reminding us that we are never alone in our struggles. It can ease depression and anxiety symptoms; it helps soothe or calm our strong emotions; it helps build helpful parts of our brain that help with regulation and wisdom.

Incorporating scripture into your meditation by selecting a verse that resonates with you can add to this beneficial experience. For instance, Philippians 4:6-7 reminds us to present our worries to God and experience His peace.

Adoration, which takes place on Wednesdays at the parish, provides a profound opportunity for personal reflection and spiritual renewal in the presence of the Eucharist. Our parish also has a prayer group, a bible study and a men's fellowship group. Prayer serves as a form of meditation by fostering a deep, mindful connection with the divine, allowing for introspection and peace.
