Lunch will include pizza and salad.

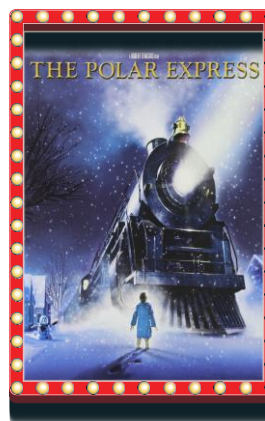
