SPOTLIGHT ON VOLUNTEERS

Catechetical Correspondence – Rudin and Dowling Knights work with the parish in monitoring and marking students' work, (outside of our parish schools), who require catechism by correspondence, in order to receive the sacraments of First Communion, and Confirmation at St. Augustine's. RCIA – Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

St. Augustine RCIA volunteers provide instruction and preparation for adults and older children who wish to be baptized in the Catholic Church, and for those converting to Catholicism. They help the Pastor evaluate suitability of candidates/catechumens; they organize and facilitate formation programs for the candidates; they also attend RCIA rituals. The candidates' preparation culminates at Holy Saturday Mass, where they are baptized/confirmed as Catholics.
