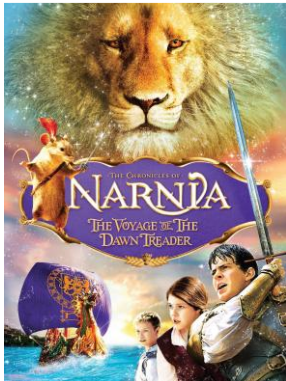
Card Pickup: Weekend of February 21/22
