BUILDING FUND & DEBT REPAYMENT UPDATE

At its recent meeting, the Finance Committee decided that all Building Fund contributions for 2025 will be set aside for repayment of our parish's renovation loan with the Diocese. The committee has also agreed that all Building Fund contributions in 2026 will likewise be directed entirely toward the debt repayment.

Monthly Pre-Authorized Giving can be directed to the debt repayment, please contact the parish office to make arrangements.

Special Debt Repayment Envelopes are available at the back of the church. If you wish to make a donation specifically toward reducing our diocesan loan incurred due to the renovations, any contributions made using these envelopes will go directly to the debt repayment fund.

All funds collected through these means are being pooled, and the parish will be entering into discussions with the Diocese at the end of 2026 to negotiate favourable repayment terms.

We thank all parishioners for their continued generosity and support as we work together to strengthen the financial foundation of St. Augustine's.

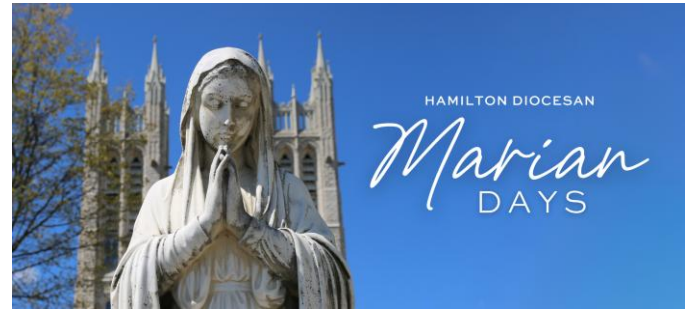


CALLING ALL GARDENERS!
